











Foreword



This booklet provides information on training courses for schools in ICT and e-learning SLAs 1, 2 or 3. The courses are free to schools who are members of the particular SLA the course relates to, this is clearly indicated at the bottom of each course page.

Where the course is purely information giving and not training, the course is free to all schools, for example headteacher and teacher briefings.

Schools not in the SLAs, are able to access the courses, but will be charged at the following rates for attendance:

Full day course = £120

Half Day Course = £60

Twilight = £30

The e-Learning and ICT team operate three SLAs:

SLA 1—provides access to training, support, guidance and courses.

SLA 2—access to NorTLE learning platform and support setup and accounts (support and training on the use of NorTLE is provided through SLA 1).

SLA 3—Access to e-safety support including PCE software and console, training and half termly reports.

In addition the team is able to respond to requests for support from schools on a wide range of e-learning and ICT issues, delivering whole staff training or individual support, helping to plan, resource, deliver and assess learning experiences using ICT in the classroom.

This year we have integrated the fantastic i am learning resources into your NorTLE learning platform.

i am learning uses games to motivate learners, it facilitates effective homework, revision and exam practice whilst promoting independent learning.

Teachers can set self-marking homework alongside student driven knowledge consolidation; with meaningful reports with detailed gap analysis to identify weaknesses, monitor progress and help improve learning outcomes.



These twilight sessions will take staff though how to set up and use i am learning effectively in your school. IAL can be used for homework, in class consolidation and also intervention strategies. It's great as a focus for lunchtime and after school clubs and provides resources for Key stage 1 to 4.

As well as an overview of IAL we will look at setting homework, tracking pupil progress and gap analysis.

Investigating iPads

Half term loans to try out iPads in your classroom

Mobile devices like tablets and smartphone are starting to become an integral part of pupil's lives.

From October ½ term we will be loaning out sets of 6 iPad 3's to trial their usage in your school/classroom. The iPad sets come with a range of software and all the kit you need to charge, store and project your iPad onto the whiteboard.



This is a pilot to help schools (and us!) evaluate the use of iPads in the classroom. There are lots of easy to use Educational apps for the iPad and the loan of a set of 6 will not only provide an opportunity to try these out with pupils but also to answer some of the teacher/classroom management issues such as:

How to deploy apps on multiple devices

How to print from an iPad

Storing and sharing pupil work

Displaying your iPad on the whiteboard projector

This half day course will cover these aspects of iPad use as well as giving participants time to explore and familiarise themselves with the device. Sessions will be limited to 6 schools per course to ensure sufficient loan kits are available.

More than 40 schools now have a school website provided and managed through NorTLE.

Features include:

- Simple to add newsletters, notices and pictures.

eSchool is an easy and effective way of ensuring your website is up to date and easy to access.



This half day course will take participants through the simple set up procedures needed to build your eSchools website. eSchools is accessed through a simple web based menu, no website publishing skills or knowledge are needed and by the end of the session participants will have all the skills necessary to maintain and develop their own website.

There is a one off charge of £150 for the set up and hosting of your eSchools website, after which the service is free as part of NorTLE.

Children use j2e intuitively, just like a sheet of paper. The ease of use encourages their natural creativity. The user interface is the result of many years experience of what really works in an educational document processor.

Combine text, graphics, animations, sounds, videos and embedded objects on a single page.

J2e is an online, fun, creative tool. No software to install, use any browser, anytime, anywhere.



J2e offers much more than simple desk top publishing – from animated text, wordless, wordlists, mathematical measurement tools to text filled with pictures or online forms. J2e has lots to offer.

This half day course provides an opportunity for colleagues unfamiliar with j2e to explore the wide range of tools and make sure they are getting the most from this great application.

Following the course there will be a J2webby session which looks at how j2e can be used for blogging pupil work to the school website.





Words of War

A new interactive resources for literacy

Words of War is a fantastic new interactive learning resource specially commissioned from Shoofly for Northumberland schools.

Words of War uses original archive material from the Northumberland Fusiliers museum at Alnwick. It focuses on six letters home from a soldier and takes us through his journey as a fusilier.

Based around six separate sessions which cover conscription, basic training, going to France, Battle of the Somme, being sent home wounded and Armistice, these resources are accessed through NorTLE.



There is a wealth of resources focussing on each video based episode.

We are quickly approaching the centenary of the First World War, running training in the summer term will give teachers time to become familiar with the resource and build it into their planning for the centenary year.

Anne Curtis, the director and creative genius behind Shoofly, has provided us with the scripts for the sessions and our team will run 6 online sessions for schools.



There are three parts to each session; an introduction, a video of Bonnie Annie and a conclusion.

E-Safety

Thinkuknow introduction course

As part of our integrated E-Safety strategy all schools are expected to have a designated person for E-Safety who has been CEOP or LA trained. This course will be of interest to designated members of staff and others with an interest in e safety.



This half day training course gives an introduction to the work of CEOP, demonstrates how young people are using technology, outlines some of the associated risks, and preventative measures that can be undertaken. Finally the course introduces you to the Thinkuknow education resources for all ages and, if relevant, trains you in how to deliver the Thinkuknow presentation to 11 – 16 year olds.

Thinkuknow training has been running for over two years in Northumberland. In that time we have trained over a large number of professionals. We offer a Thinkuknow Introduction course for those who work directly with children and young people.

We only train Enhanced CRB cleared (or equivalent) professionals who will directly deliver CEOP's products and resources to children. You will be asked to confirm you work in a school and bring a copy of your current Enhanced CRB and photo ID to the training course. Without these documents, you may not be permitted to attend.
