runs from May 2017 to February 2018.

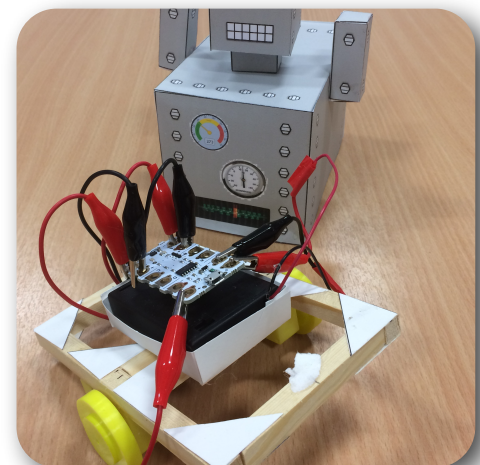
We have lots of activities and courses taking place around the County in the coming year and are keen to involve as many teachers and schools as possible.

To make our sessions easier to get to, we are running as the majority in three venues around the County - North, Central and West.

The programme of Hub meetings has been expanded this year. Hub meetings are run by local teachers and provide an opportunity to meet with colleagues from neighbouring schools and share ideas, as well as hearing about new resources.

We have Hub meetings running in Belford, Alnwick, Rothbury, Bedlington, Hexham and Haydon Bridge. They are free, open to all teachers and in our first session we are giving away free Ozobots!

Our learning platform School360 continues to develop. In the coming year we are



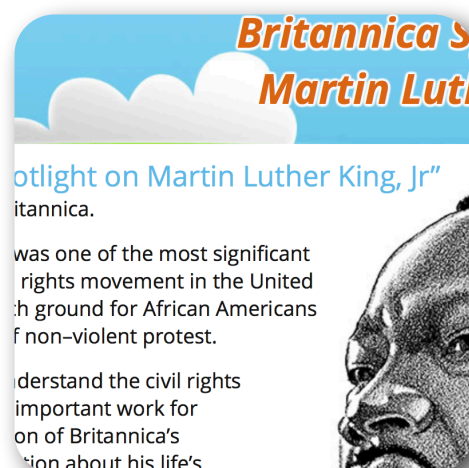
Using School360 to register classes is becoming more popular and we have partnered with a company called Wonde to offer registration into Sims through School360 for free to all schools next year.

This year we experimented with breaking down a half day course into two twilights and running it locally at the request of a school. They arranged for their staff and staff from neighbouring schools to attend and we did all the rest. If there is a course in the booklet that you would like running at your school and you think you could get six staff, from your school or neighbouring schools to attend, contact the ICT team to make arrangements.

Schools in SLA1 have free and unlimited access to these, though none SLA schools and out of County schools may attend on payment of a fee.








